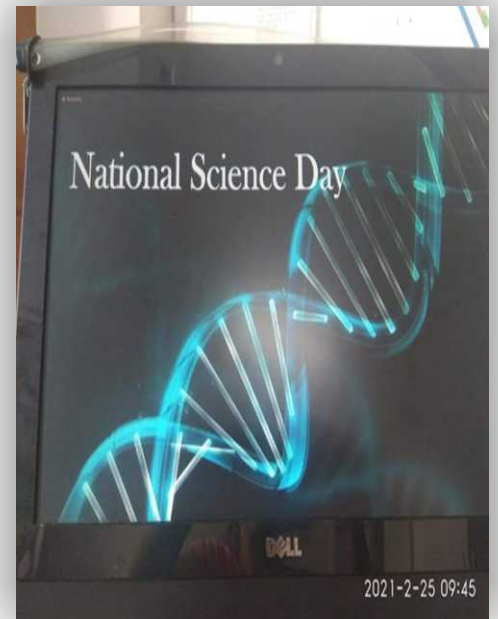


It also created an environment for face to face interactions between the recruiters and the aspirants. The platform was created to provide the students with exposure of sitting for interviews and facing them.

There were a total of 26 institutions last year that participated in the first day of the recruitment drive. Also in pandemic situation online recruitments done from March 2021 to July 2021. There were nearby 10 schools participated in online recruitments. Still many schools are approaching and accordingly our student teachers will be placed as per requirements of the School as well as in Junior Colleges.

- Advantages of access to library.

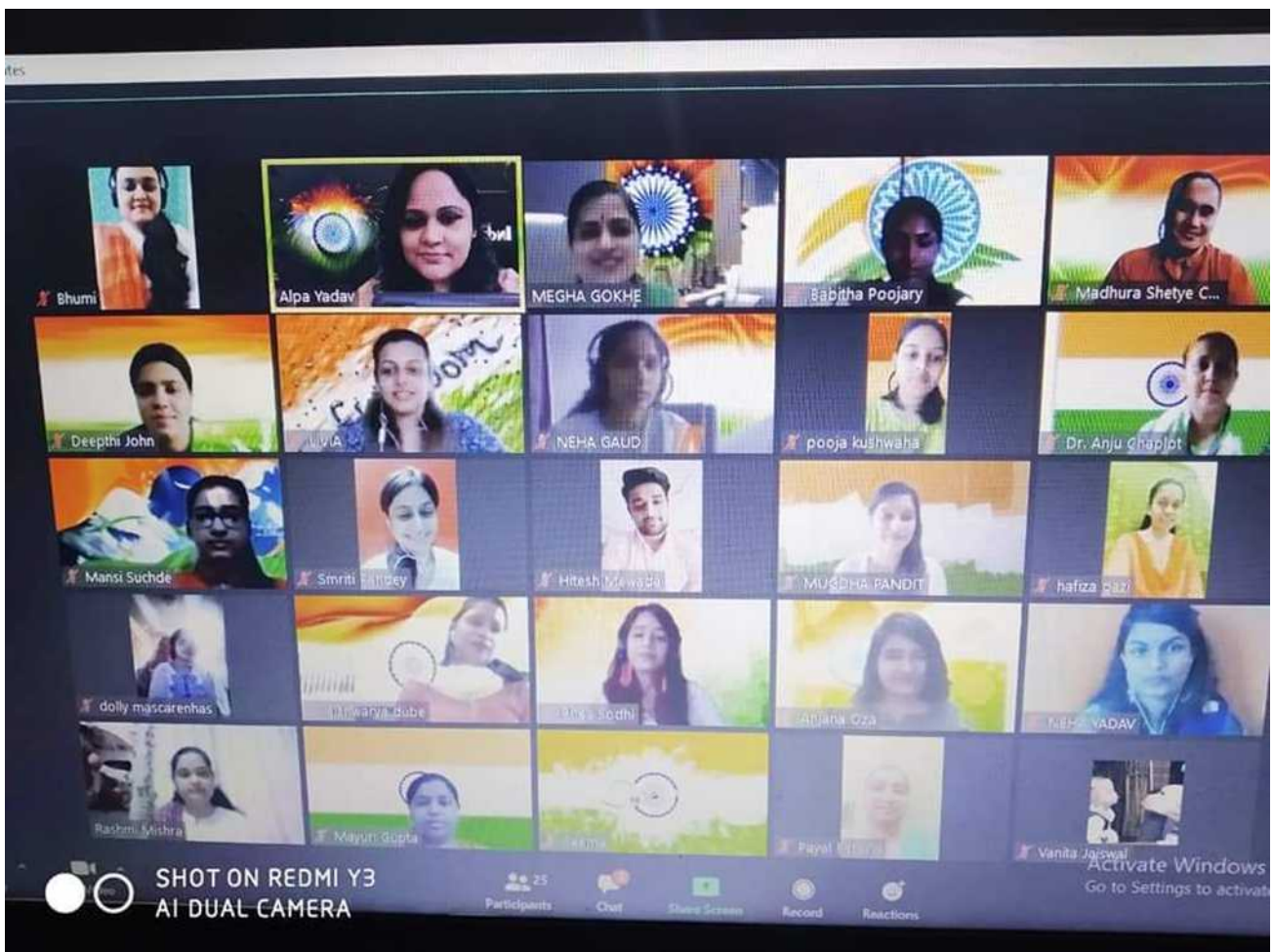
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

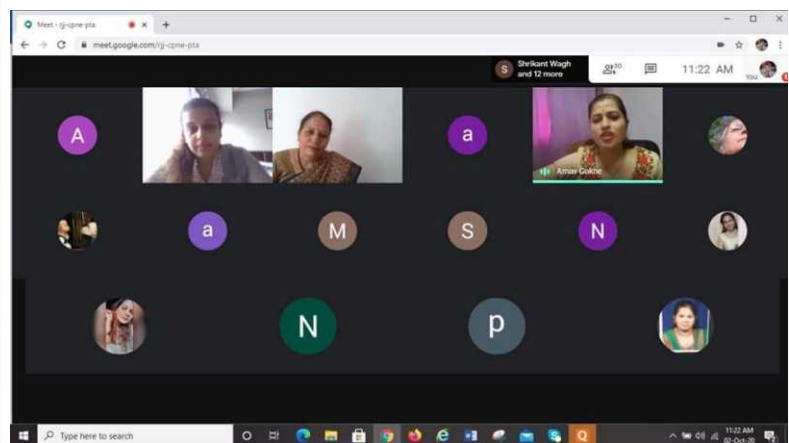
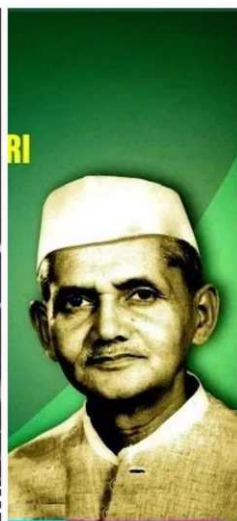
10th October, 2020 – Expert Online Webinar Nai – Talim in Today's Times

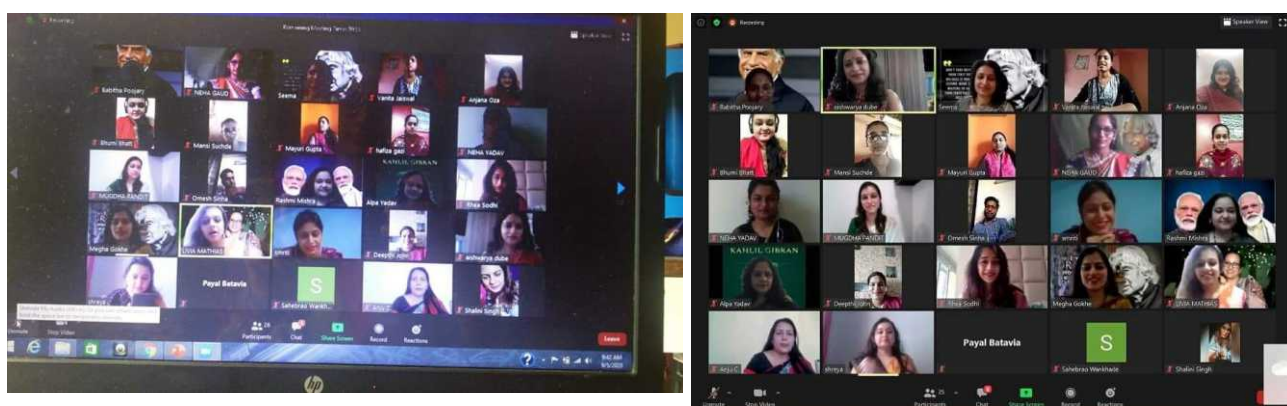
- 1) Education in mother tongue along with handicraft work.

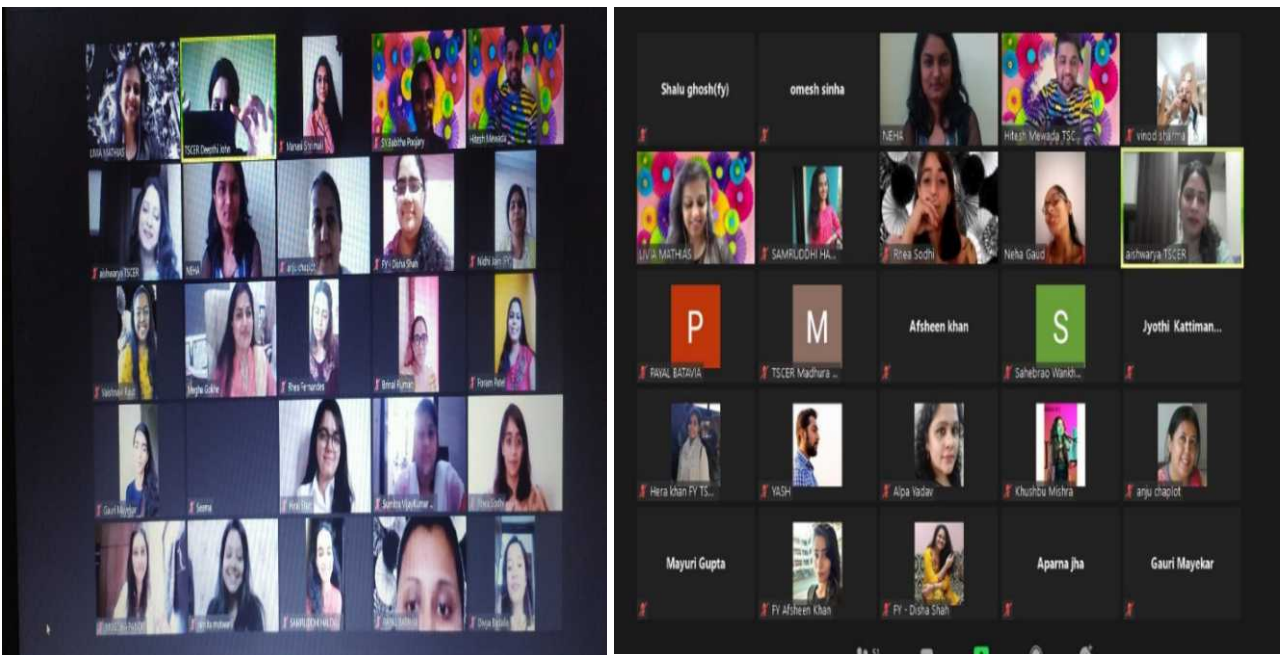
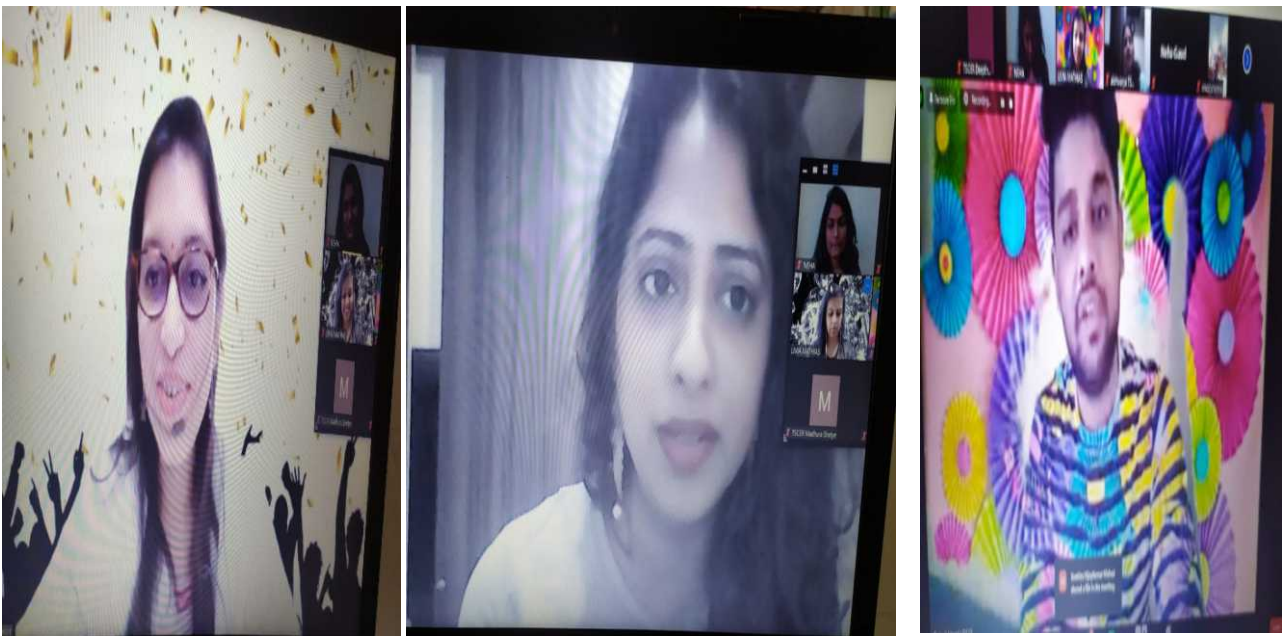
Online Christmas Celebration-24th Dec, 2020

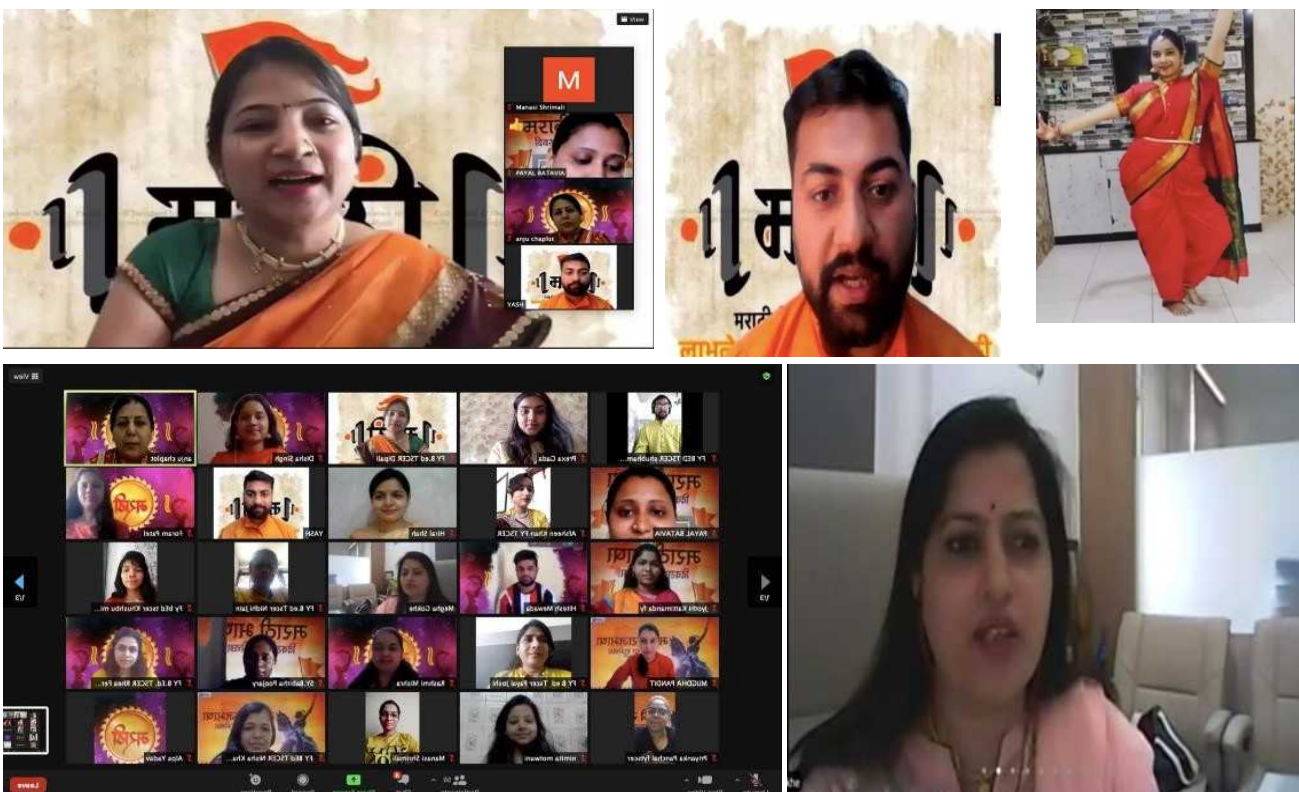
Online Fresher's Party-26th Feb,2021

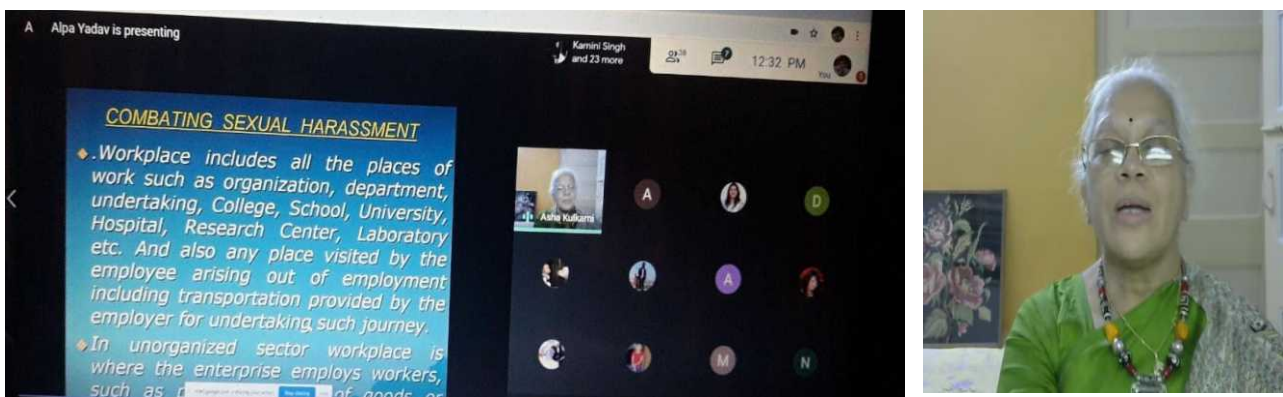
Technological Discourse Programme, Under IQAC Cell – Google Forms

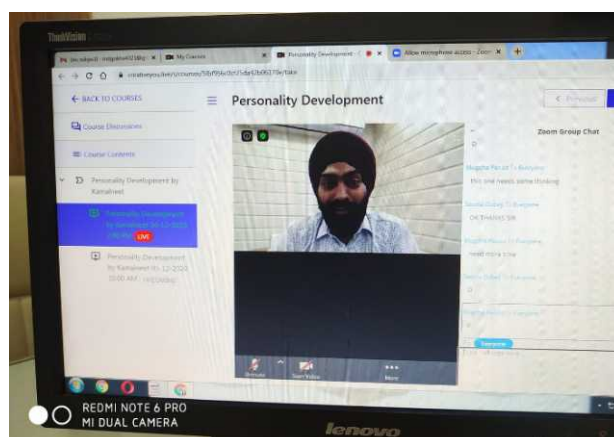
1. Sexual Harassment of Women in Workplace – Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal, POSH, WDC Cell

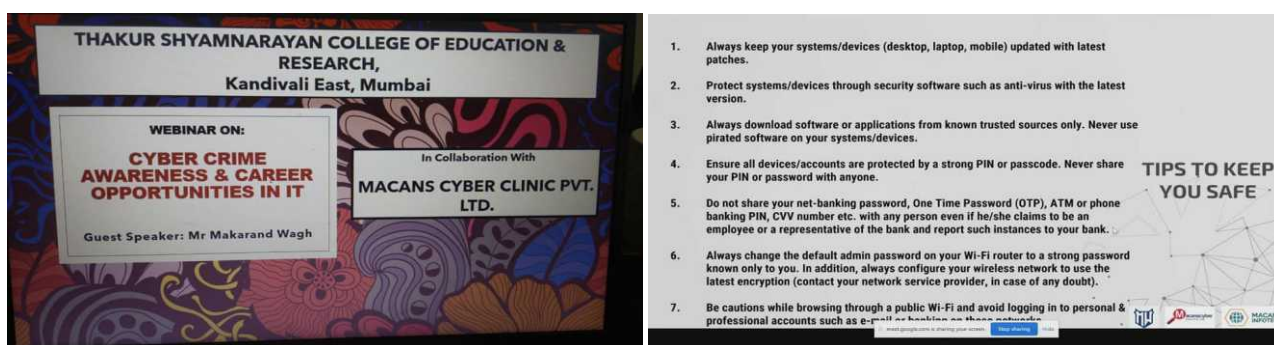
2. Personality Development Workshop

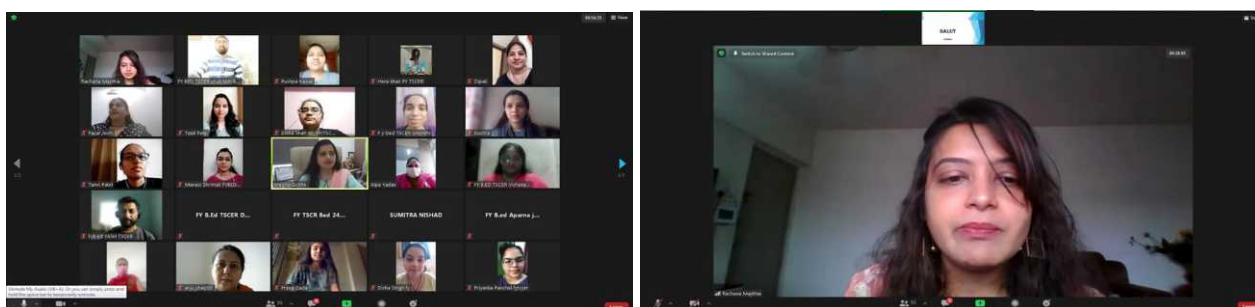


4. MPC Online Training Program

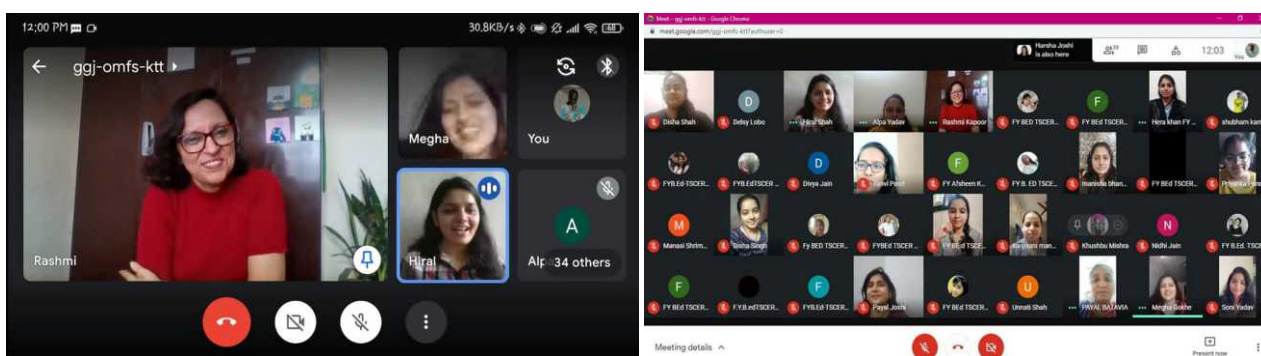
5. Importance of French Language

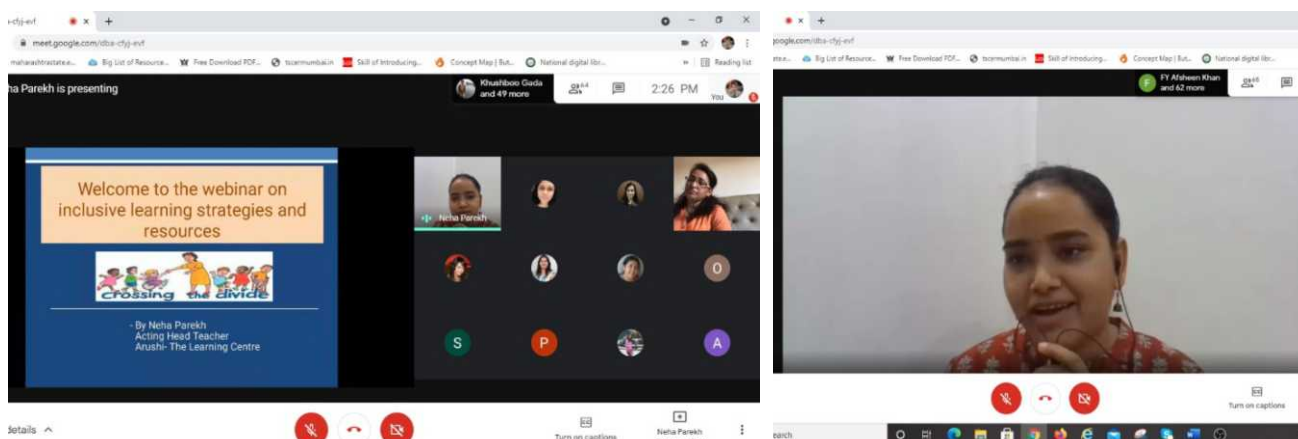
6. Stress Detoxification Mantra

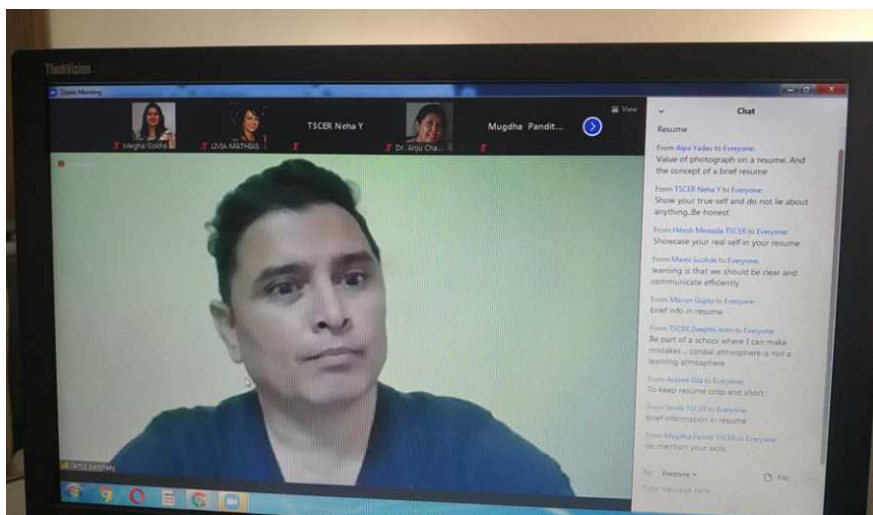
7. Inclusive teaching strategies & resources

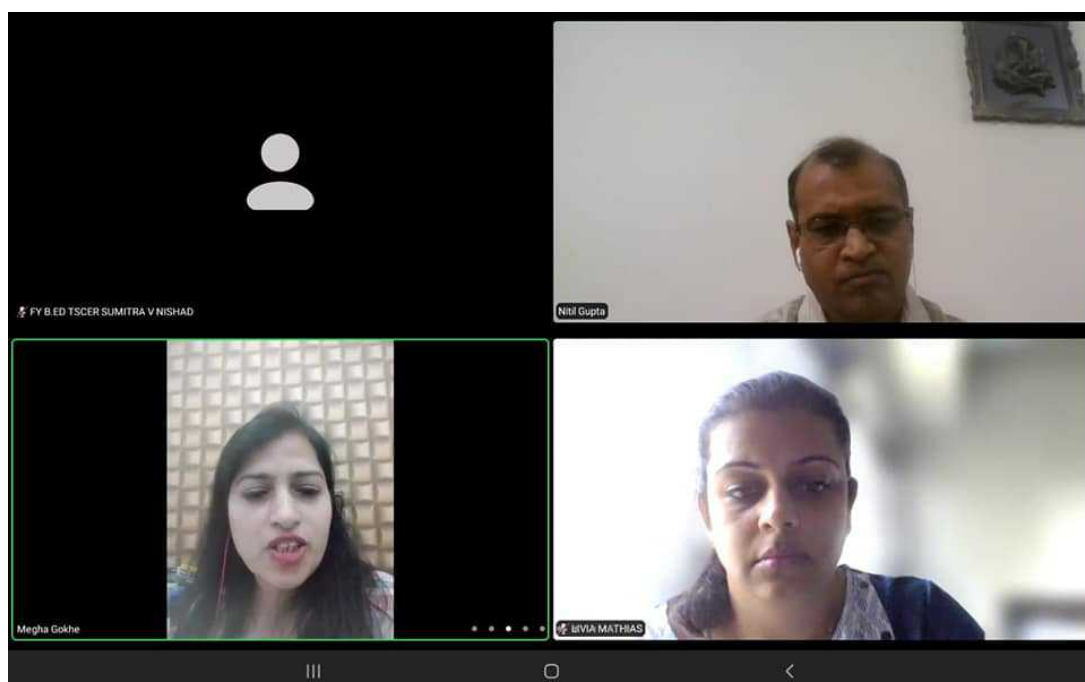


9. Counselling Sessions for University Exam

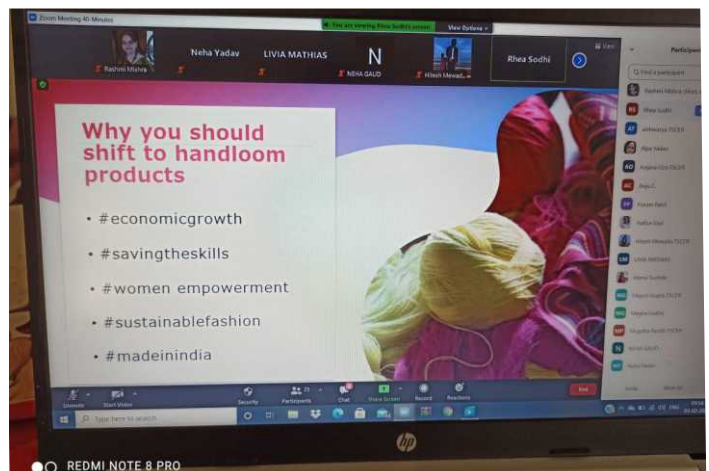
Participants: - The program was attended by the principal of TSCER group, teaching staff and student teachers

Feedback and Future Perspective: -

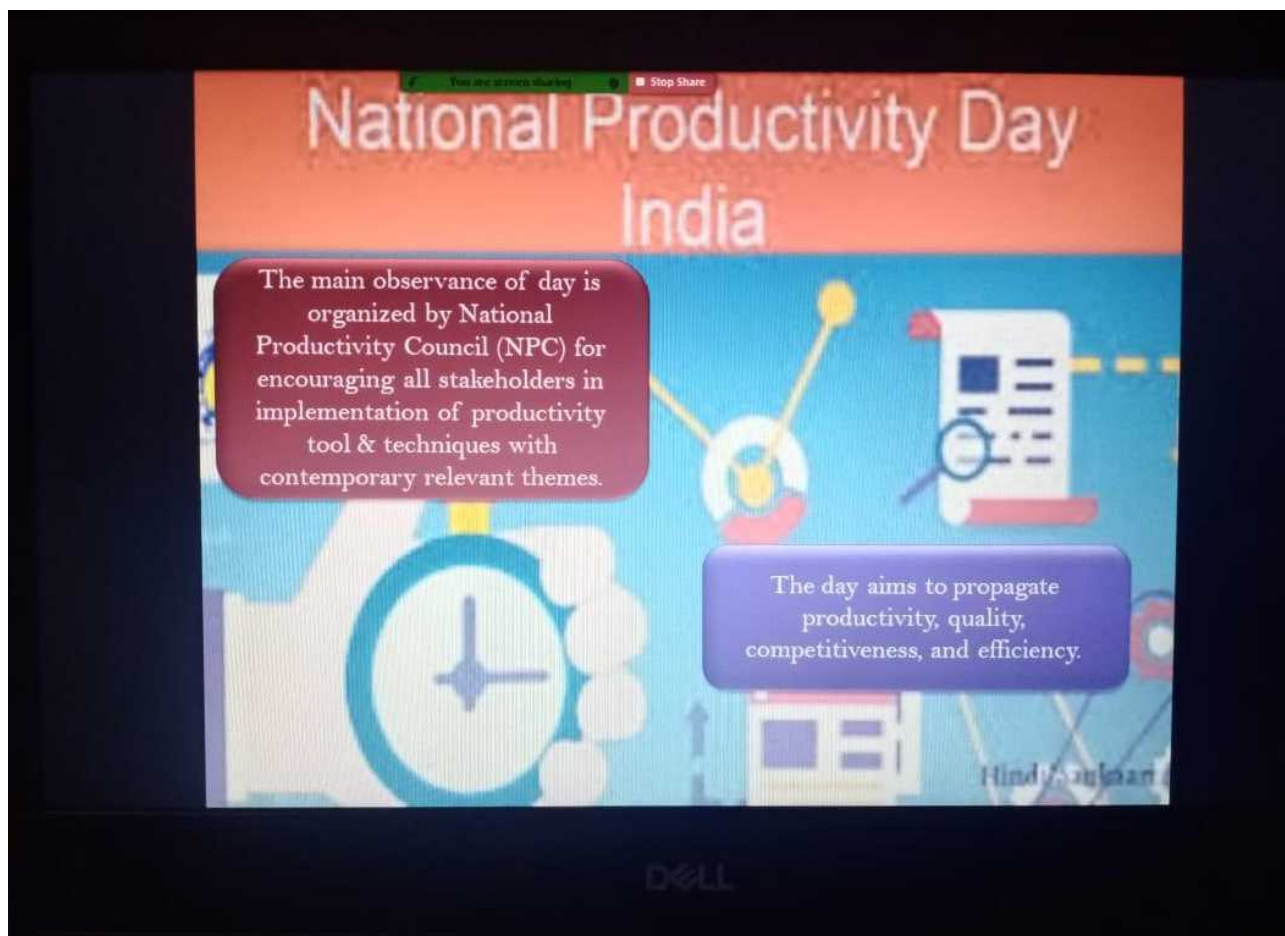

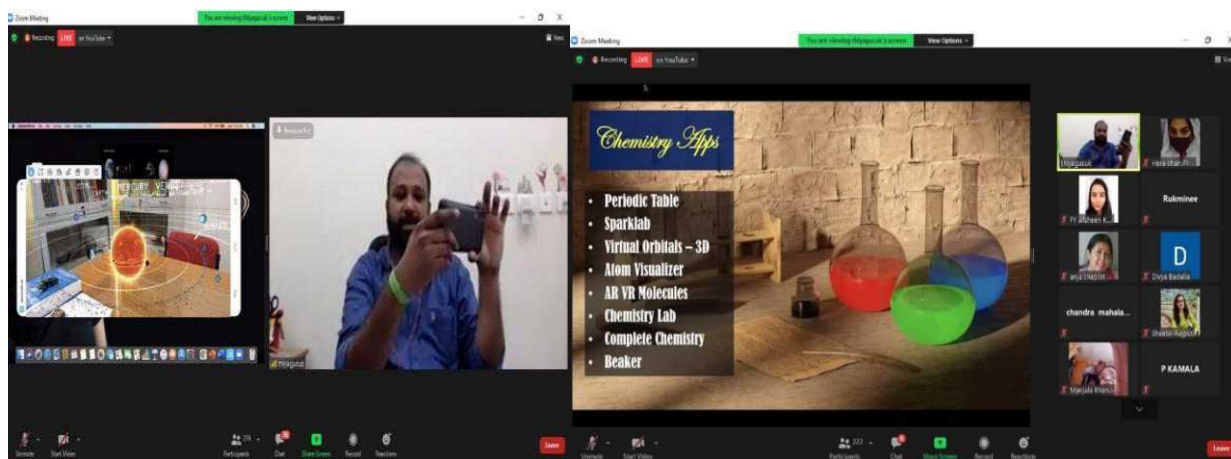
MAJOR WORKSHOP & SEMINAR
