COLLEGE LIBRARY

The Library of Thakur Shyamnarayan College of Education and Research is a treasure house of knowledge. It has a good collection of books, magazines, education related journals, Encyclopedia, Reference books, CDs, along with daily newspaper. The year's efforts were done to make the library richer and up to date. At the beginning we had 3152 books in the library and now 5829 books have available in our library .The library currently subscribe about 20 journals and magazines and 8 newspapers in different language.

The students and teachers has actively used the library for their knowledge enrichment and reference. We provide them easy accessibility to variety of books which are useful to them for practice teaching. EXTENSION WORK

The college also participated in the Annual Festival, "Udaan - the flight of Extension" organized by DLLE and won second prize in Street Play competition.

One of our students participated for UDAN: Flight of Extension 2020, the audition for hosting the event was held in the month of January. There were around more than 200 students from all over Mumbai. Our student Ms Aishwarya Dubey got selected to host the event and got the certificate for the same.

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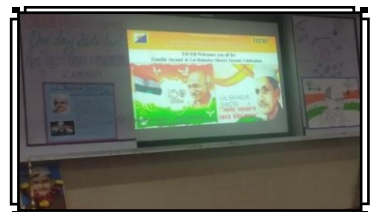
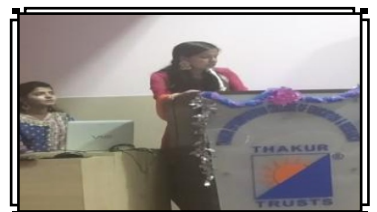
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ASSEMBLY

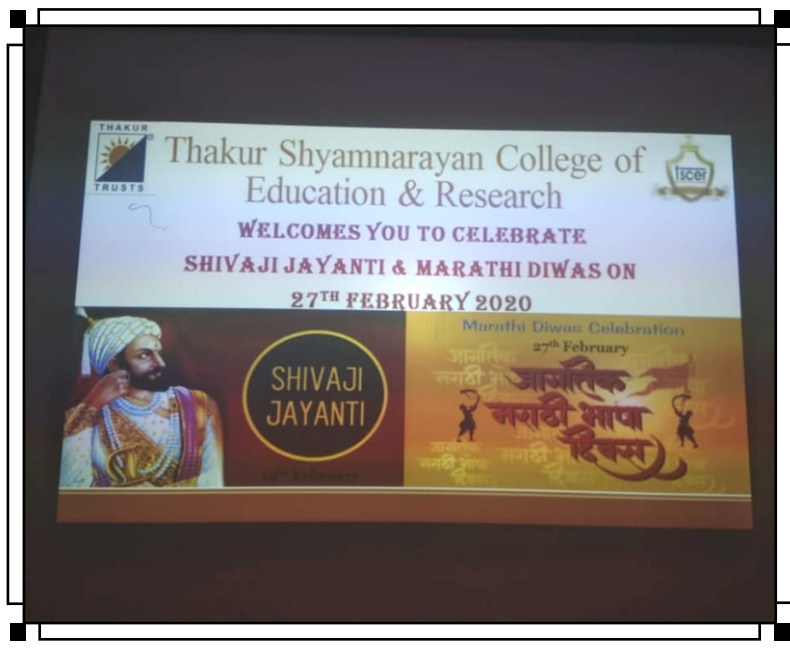
DEGREE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY

• **Mock Interview and Session on “How to Face an Interview” by school of London by Pinky Tripathi**

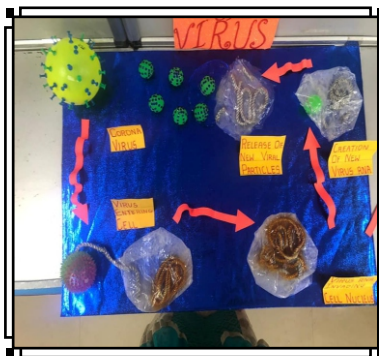

Inauguration, Welcome and Felicitation

The session started by kindling lamp by Dr Sunita Magre, chairman BoS Education Department, University of Mumbai, the chief guest, Dr Shubajit Maity, Guest of Honour, Chief instructor of Aviation at TS College of Aviation engineering, Mrs. Megha D. Gokhe Principal, Thakur Shyamnarayan College of Education and Research (TSCER) and Mr. Prabhaker Banala resource person of MGNCRE-Hyderabad and followed by prayer.

Dignitaries on the dais spoke on the subject and importance of Nai Talim and its relevance in current education system. Introduction by Resource Person

Resource person from MGNCRE-Hyderabad has discussed on farms established by Gandhiji in South Africa(1893-1914) and Wardha education conference(Oct.1937) where Gandhiji insisted on the introduction of Nai Talim, experiential learning, work education and community engagement (Basic education, BuniyadiShiksha) in place of the then existing colonial Macaulay system of education which is totally devoid of Indian values and alienating the work from education. He also focussed on salient features of Kothari commission and SUPW. He expressed the opinion that art, craft, sports, music and dance should be regarded very much as part of curriculum.



Session 1 PRA/PLA

The real India lies in the rural areas. Around 70% of India's population constitutes of rural regions. India's growth and progress cannot be complete unless there is collective growth across all the sections of society. Thus, PRA and PLA techniques were explained to understand the problems of Village and devising solutions for them.

A session on community engagement was conducted by ppt on PRA/PLA techniques to be adopted during village visit. PRA Enable local people to carry out their own analysis, to plan and to take part to build their own tools based on principle of visualisation and documentation. The PLA is the latest approach being followed to conduct appraisal and developing learning about the pros and cons of living in village and provide recommendations in the form of Action Plan, to panchayat secretaries which can be used to improve the conditions and life of people in village areas. The presentation sensitised about why the awareness of understanding about the problems of villages is important and how we as teachers can use the same to develop sensitivity amongst urban student about importance of village society. Using this bottom up approach and appraisal will help urban student to contribute in growth of villages and subsequently and truly balanced Indian society.

Session 2 Village Poster

Session on village mapping on charts by all five groups and their presentation with peculiar features that makes their village an ideal one was performed. All the participants were asked to introduce themselves and grouped into 5 groups. Each group was given a specific name selected by the choice of the group members. Five Groups were Formed Group 1: Water, Group 2: Aakash, Group 3: Earth, Group 4: Air, Group 5; Fire

The activity included the following:

- A Chart to be made in each of the five groups depicting their idea of an ideal village.
- Each Group was asked to present their idea of villages they have seen or an ideal village they would like to see.
- Some about technology, smart village, self help groups, well planned townships, environment friendly, perseverance of culture, green library, organic farming, seed bank to collect different types of seeds produced on the farms
- This activity helped to bring out creative imagination and understanding about various aspects of village life from multiple perspectives.
- This knowledge gained, to help student teachers build these skills, and promote imagination and creativity amongst children through group learning, creating an experiential learning environment.



Session 3 Averages and Measurements

The groups measured the average height and average weight of the groups using measuring tapes and weighing scales. The individual groups then measured the height and weight and calculated the average height and weight of the group. Mr. Prabhaker then mentioned how the activity can be used to teach students about teamwork. With the help of a beautiful example he explained how these activities can be used to tell children that individual negative or shortcomings are added up to become positive,

Task 4: Nai-Talim Shanti Niketan Video

A clip was screened on Nai Talim school, Anand Niketan at Wardha and the participants discussed on the teaching methodology in school and salient features which made it an ideal school. The video showed how the use of Hands Head and Heart can bring about all round development in students. The video showed how this school and its curriculum was formed. The school emphasized on physical work. The video showed instances where boys and girls together were working in the farm, boys cooking food, girls carrying heavy objects, boys engaging in tailoring and many more.

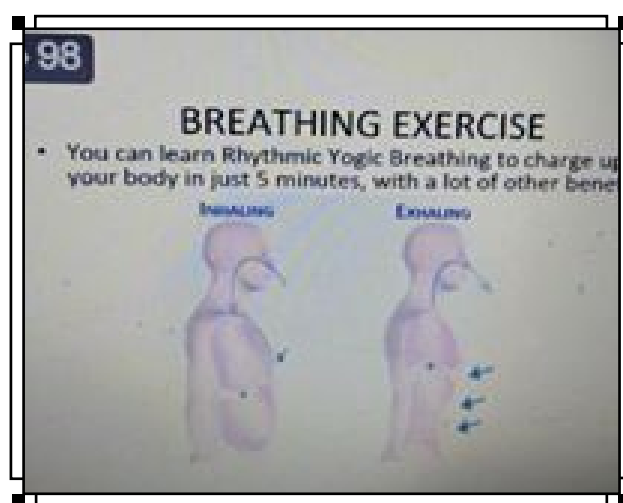
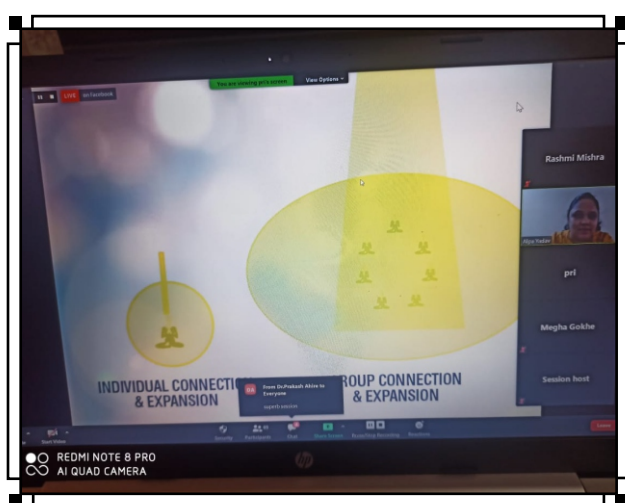
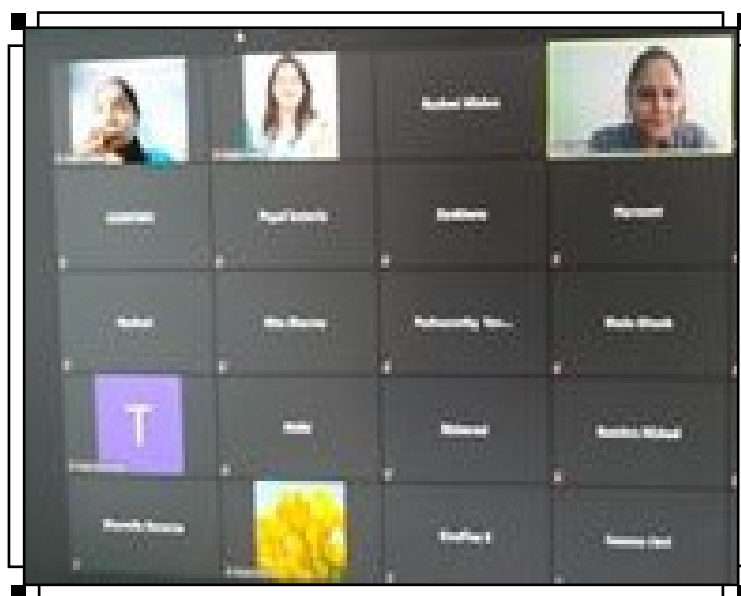
LOCKDOWN EVENTS

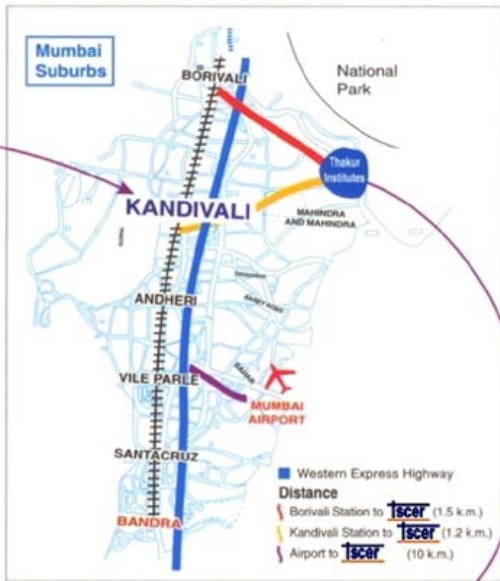

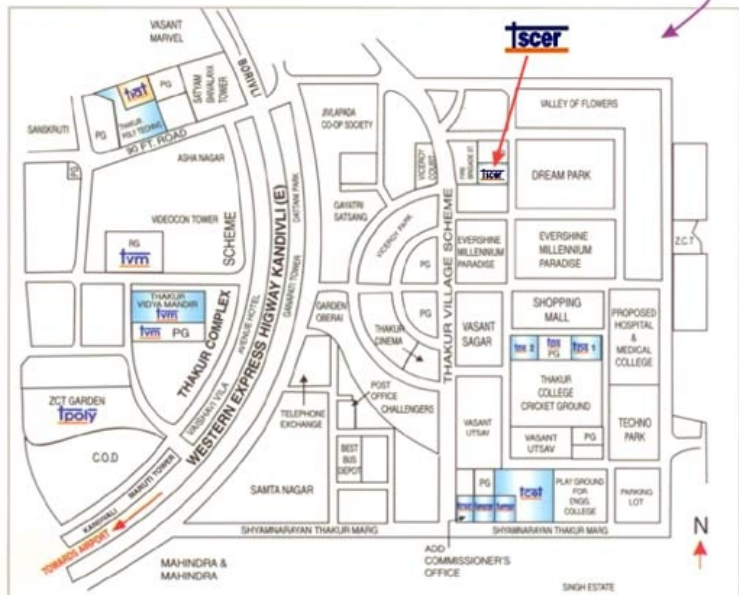
