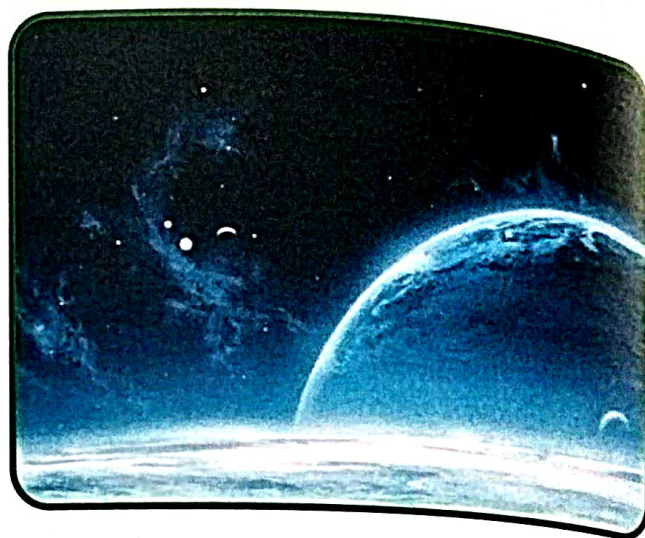
I extend my heartfelt gratitude to Shri Rakesh Singh, and our august trustees for their support, guidance and contribution always.

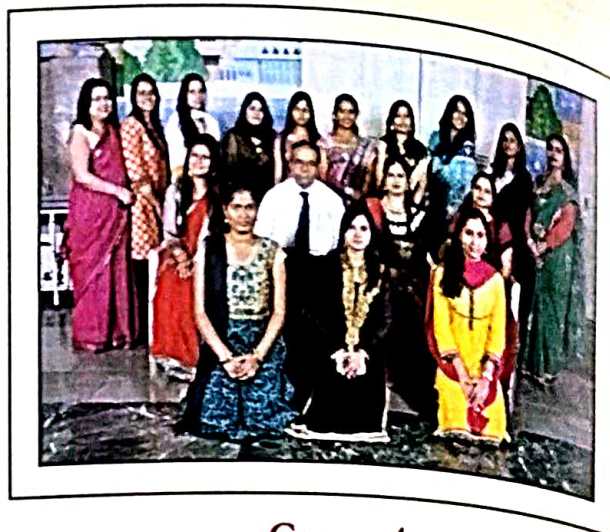

B.Ed. Two Years Course Discussion Meeting

In collaboration with Observer Research Foundation (ORF) Mumbai TSCER had organized a discussion on the “Norms and Regulations proposed by the committee created by NCTE under the chairmanship of Prof PoonamBatra for reforms in teacher education. On 2nd Aug, 2014 This committee came out with a draft report that contains regulations and procedures for various teacher education programmes. There have been mixed reactions as well as some apprehensions regarding certain critical aspects that surface in the report regarding the two year B.Ed programme amongst teacher educators. Thus to collaboratively analyse and comprehend these regulations and norms in the wake of the existing teacher education scenario, TSCER has taken an initiative for this various delegates such as Principals, faculty members from different teacher education institutes as well as schools had participated in this discussion and gave their valuable suggestions.



Extension Work

Under the supervision of Dr. Arvind Luhar, the Field Coordinator, the college registered 74 student-teachers for the extension work activities with the Department of Lifelong Learning Extension (DLLE), University of Mumbai. National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) and the Survey of Women's Status (SWS) were the two projects under which the student-teachers had been enrolled.

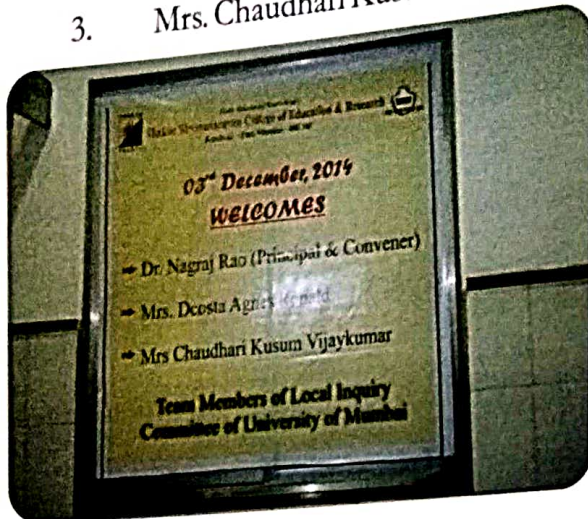

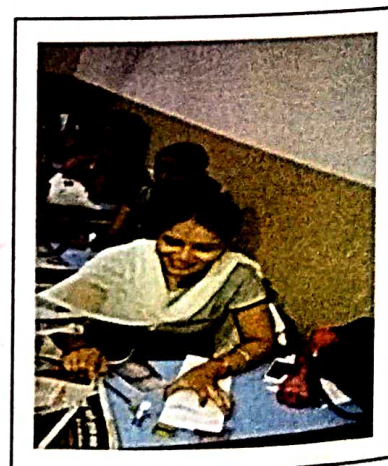


STUDENTS PARTICIPATION

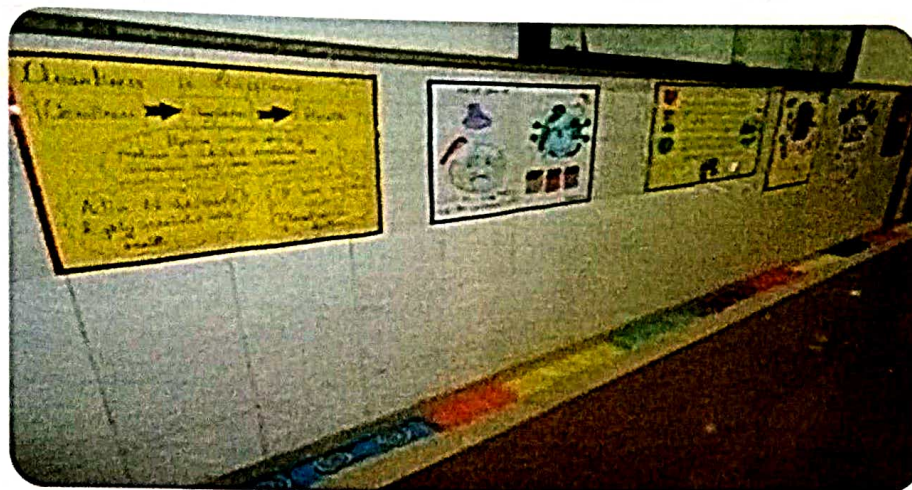
Best Out Of Waste Competition

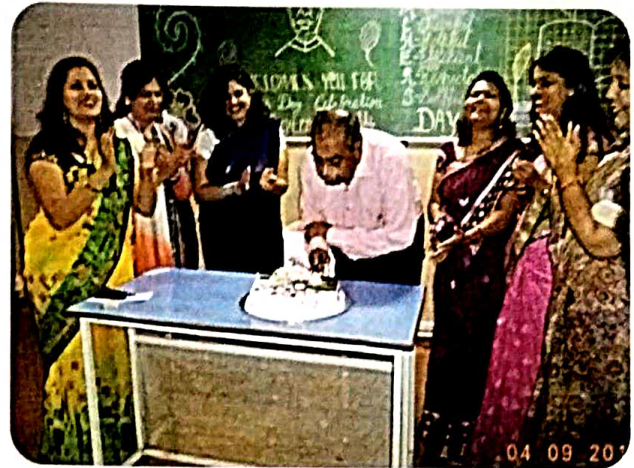
Independence Day

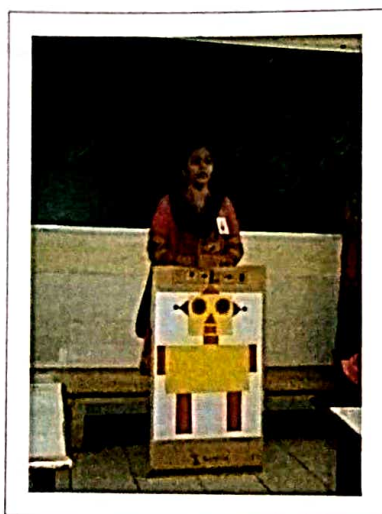

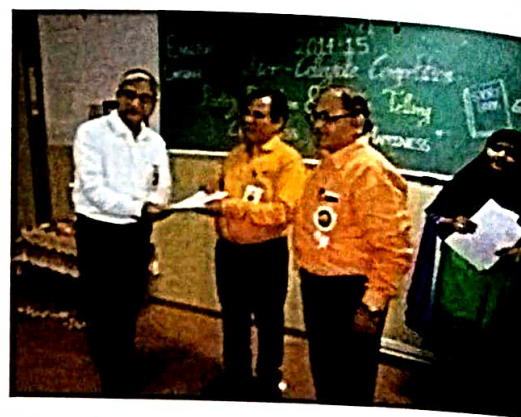

Annual Seminar

In today's fast paced modern world, the younger generation is prone to conflicts, stress related problems, anxiety etc. To overcome these problems and to lead the citizens of tomorrow to a bright future some intervention is required. Life skill is such an intervention that will help to deal with such problems. It can not only be used as an intervention but as a preventive approach also and it is applicable to any field. Keeping this in mind TSCER organized seminar cum Workshop on life skill education which covered key life skills and competencies that empowered the participants to enhance the quality of their life. The seminar cum Workshop was conducted on 10th and 11th April 2015 on "Empowering Teachers with Life Skills Education". There were seven different sessions and the renowned experts from respective fields were invited for each session.

Day 1: 10th April, 2015 Friday

Session I

The first session of the seminar was Understanding life skill education and its inevitability in today's time which was taken by **Dr. Satish Chandra Kumar, Head of Department, Dept of Applied Psychology, University of Mumbai.**

Dr. Satish spoke about self-empowerment and development of human potential through enhancement of life skills. He emphasized that life is looking inward and forward externally. He stressed that it is thought which defines mind, mind defines emotions and emotions define behavior.



Session II

Session two of the first day was on Interpersonal relationship skill – understanding yourself and others which was taken by **Mr. Vivek Patki, Corporate Trainer.** Mr. Patki started his session by creating awareness of two way communication. He also talked about 4 A's i.e, attention, acceptance, approval, appreciation and adulation. He stressed on active listening, use I statements to prevent conflicts and to sort them out. The entire session was an interactive session and Mr. Patki beautifully made a balance between the activity and knowledge part.



Session III

The last session of day one was on Communication skill – express one's self effectively which was taken by **Dr. Avinash De Sousa, Consultant Psychiatrist & Psychotherapist, Consultant School Psychiatrist & Counsellor.** Dr. Avinash emphasized on teacher student communication skill. He stressed that communication is the key to face different types of students, parents and principals. He spoke about giving exposure to students to ask questions, learn to go beyond textbook. His views demonstrated his ideology about student teacher communication.



Day 2: 11th April, 2015 Saturday

Session I

The second day began with the prayer which was followed by the session on Leadership skills – become effective leaders of today and tomorrow taken by **Mr. Sunil Raikar, Corporate Trainer & Motivational Speaker.**

Lots of activities were the part of the session. He discussed his views on the true sense of developing leadership skill in one's own self. He brought into notice very beautifully that a person who takes initiative, passionate, take quick decisions can be a good leader. He talked about 7 C's which are required for one self to be a good leader – content, courage, confidence, credibility, conviction and communication. He made us aware to learn things from our own experiences.



Session II

Second session of day two was on Decision making skill – taking better decisions for better life taken by **Mrs. BijiTusharFadia, Vice Principal, VivekVidyalaya, Life Coach.**

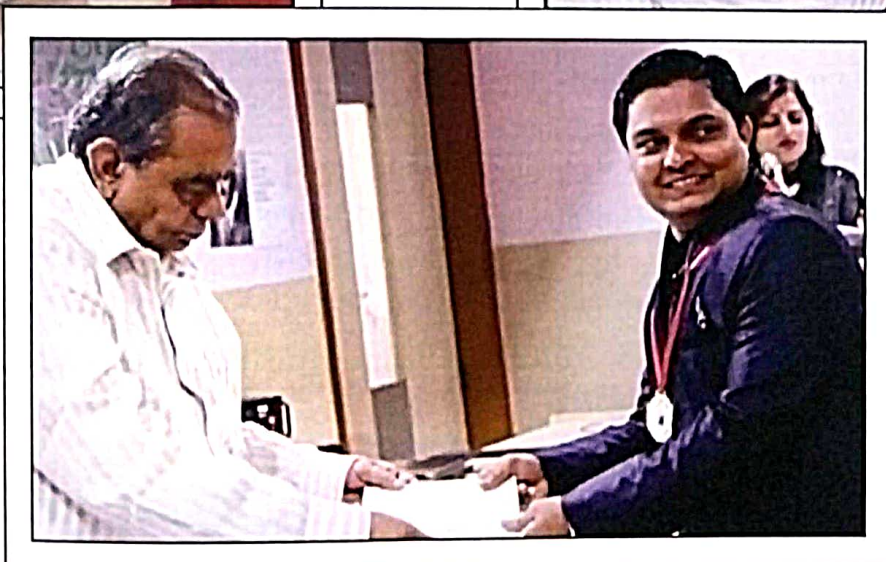


Annual Day Celebration

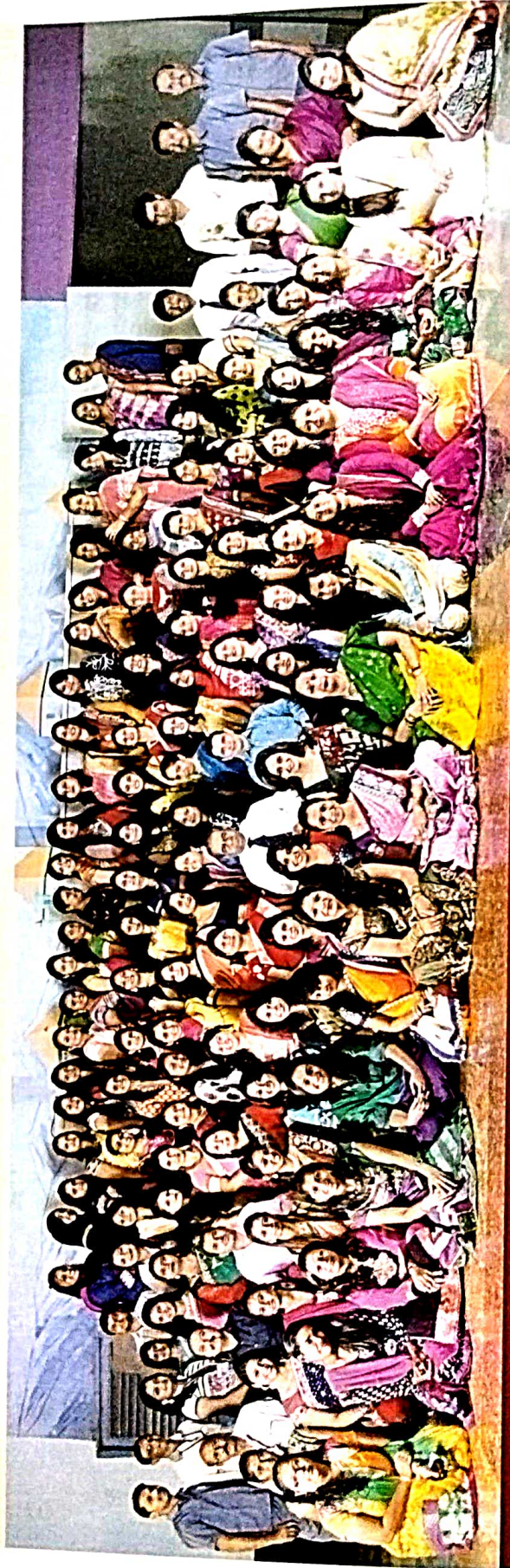

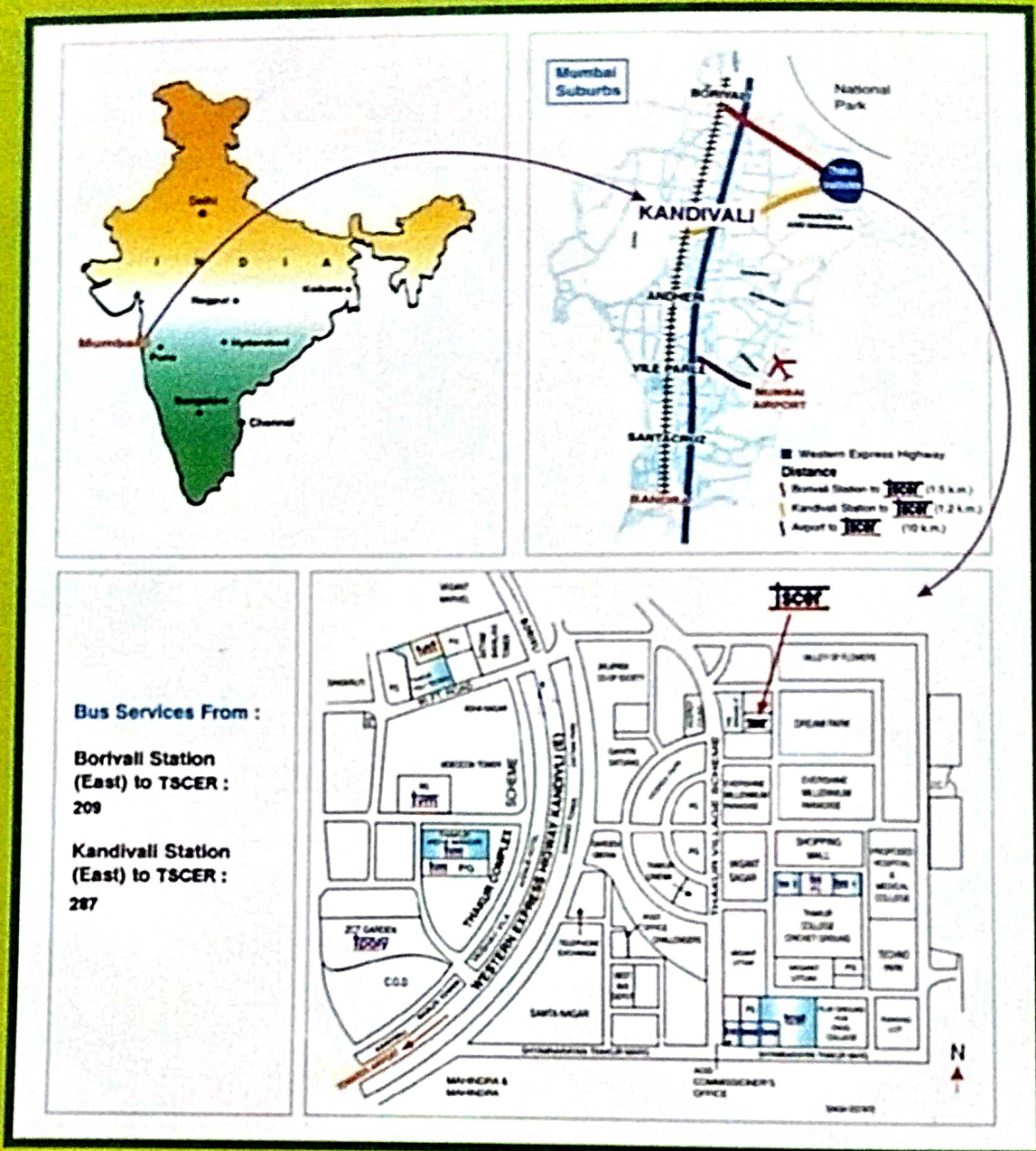
