MICROTEACHING:

The micro teaching workshop was flagged off in the month of August 2010. The student teachers were initiated into the origin, need and significance of conducting micro-teaching, prior to the actual start of their practice lessons. In the situation most feasible skills were chosen, namely:

SIMULATED LESSONS

Student-teachers were oriented to bridge lessons or simulated lessons of 15 minutes duration each. The simulated lessons included various techniques that were put forth to the student-teachers namely:

TEACHING AIDS

COMPUTER ASSISTED INSTRUCTION

Today we are part of the global village and the role of the teachers today is to prepare future global citizens. To provide hands on experience to our student-teachers on the use of Computer technology for teaching learning process, they were made to come up with **Power Point Presentations** on topics from subjects like Mathematics, Science, Economics, History and Geography. They even used these for their teaching learning, bringing a technical and modern touch to their lessons.

We trained them with Computer Assisted Instruction (CAI). Our Student-teachers prepared 200 powerpoint presentations in their both respective methods including Computer Assisted Instruction and Computer Assisted Learning.

We also oriented our student-teachers on how to use various e-learning tools and CAM studio to help them to prepare their Computer Assisted Instruction and Computer Assisted Learning presentations.

GUARDIANSHIP

This is a novel concept introduced in our college. Our staff have within themselves divided all the 100 student-teachers & they look after all of the student-teachers' confusion and clarification – viz Academic, personal, vocational and like.

Each teacher has about 12 to 15 wards under her. Guardianship Sessions have proved to be a great help to student-teachers.

RESEARCH PROJECT

Research based project work has been introduced to make would be teachers aware of the procedure of conducting the research and our student teachers have been given the opportunity to conduct action research on the classroom related issues. It may be related to content of syllabus, teachers' issues, methodology of teaching subject and student related problematic situations.

The student-teachers have chosen one such issue as per their interest and they were guided by guardian professors to carry out the action research. In all, 100 action research projects concerning various issues were conducted and submitted in this academic year.

THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

The library of Thakur college of Education is treasure house of knowledge. It has a good collection of books, encyclopedias, magazines, Reference books, C.Ds, along with Daily News Papers.

Throughout the year efforts were done to make the library richer and up-to-date. At the beginning of the B.Ed 2010-11 sessions, we had about 4129 books and currently we have 4260 books in our library. The library currently subscribes to about 33 magazines and 8 newspapers in various languages. [Detailed List of titles is attached in Appendix B]

The student-teachers have actively used the Library for their knowledge enrichment and reference. We provide them easy accessibility to variety of books which are useful for them for practice teaching, daily experiences, academic references, etc. The Librarian provides health learning environment and guided approach to quench their thirst for learning. He also takes initiatives to orient student-teachers in group of twenty to increase the utility of library.

Our Librarian Mr. S.P Wankhede and Mr. V Sharma have helped our student-teachers at each step in optimum utilization of resources available in the library.

SEMINAR/WORKSHOPS

We provide maximum exposure to our student-teachers regarding different educational aspects. By keeping this in mind we chose current academic issues and we invite best available experts to conduct various educational lectures & workshops.

DR VEENA DESHMUKH, on 6^{th} OCTOBER 2010 gave her valuable insights about **Pedagogical Analysis** to students. Dr. Veena Deshmukh, is the best resource person in Mumbai for Pedagogy and She is Hon. Professor at K.K. College of Education.

A Worshop on Jurisprudential Inquiry Model by MS. JAYSHREE INBARAJ on <u>25th October 2010</u> to help student-teachers to understand this model of teaching for effective citizenship. She is an Associate Professor at Kapila Khandwala College of Education & Research, Santacruz. The workshop emphasized the Social Interaction Model – JIM. It was an interactive experience where the students were given the opportunity to think and debate policy issues in a rational manner.

A Session on 'Systems Approach' by MS. ASHIMA DESHMUKH on 26th October 2010 to help student develop an understanding about systems approach so that they can view the educational organization as a unified, purposeful system composed of interrelated parts. Ms. Ashima Deshmukh is an Associate Professor at Kapila Khandwala College of Education & Research, Santacuz. She has written a book on Educational Management which is widely referred as a reference book for understanding the subject Educational Management at the B.Ed level. The key point highlighted was that the teacher's

role is to look at the organization as a whole or part of the larger outside environment and also to understand that activity of any part affects all other parts of the organization.
